# Firearms Training Certification

In order for Cadets/Explorers to be eligible to compete in the 2019 Public Safety Cadets National Marksmanship Competition, a qualified Firearms Instructor, certified by a law enforcement agency or the National Rifle Association of America (NRA), and the Unit Lead Mentor/Advisor must attest that each Cadet/Explorer has received a minimum of eight (8) hours of instruction in, but not limited to: fundamentals of marksmanship, safe range operations, target scoring, firearms safety, nomenclature, necessity of proper eye and ear protection, as well as proper loading of magazines. Additionally, each Cadet/Explorer must have successfully demonstrated the safe and proper handling of a semi- automatic pistol through completion of at least two Public Safety Cadets Center Fire Pistol Courses (PSCCFPC).
